

## **Exercise Induced Collapse**

Exercise Induced Collapse (EIC) is a condition which predominantly affects Labrador Retrievers. Recently, the EIC test has also been validated in Clumber spaniels in the UK. There have been a few affected Clumbers reported in Great Britain. These dogs have predominantly been from the “working” lines in the UK. To date, there have not been reports of affected dogs (either affecteds or carriers) in the US, to the best of our knowledge. This condition is NOT the same as PDP1.
